Notable

- For the tournament holes No. 9 and No. 8 will be swapped.
 Since last year a bunker was added to the left rough on No. 12 and tees, including pines, have been added around the course to work back to the original intent of the course.
- Warmer February weather helped the golf course grow out of winter traffic and playing conditions.
- Course features the smallest greens and most bunkers of tour courses played in the U.S. so far this year. (see next page)
- Assistant superintendents Carlos Duran and Javier Michel have been on the staff for more than 25 years and are a key reason why the course has remained consistent.
