- No. 16 tee was moved 25 yards to the right and a greenside bunker was removed.
- Course has seen more rain than season averages in May creating challenges.

- Maintenance crew has 10 interns who have come from France, South Africa, Tennessee, Purdue, Michigan State, Ohio State and Eastern Kentucky.
- Mak has had 6 assistants transition into superintendent roles in the last 7 years.
