Notable

- Over the last couple of years working with Davis Love III, some Pete Dye elements/features have returned to the golf course. In 2024 the following enhancements were made:
 - New tournament tee on No. 2 added 15 yards.
 - Re-established the iconic tree on No. 6 tee, while adding 15 yards (original tree was lost in 2014).
 - New tee complex on No. 11 added 15 yards.
 - Stronger, deeper and dramatic moguls with additions of palms, oaks and native grasses in the right rough on No. 14.
