### Notable

- No. 9 will play from No. 11 tee to add length to the hole, so the bunkers come into play.
- The tournament yardage is 7,352, which is identical to last week's THE PLAYERS, but par this week is 71, while last week was 72. It is the longest par-71 course played so far this year.
- Two years ago, the rough height was increased to 3.75" from 3" and the intermediate cut width around the greens was decreased to 21" from 72" to bring the rough closer to the greens.
- Superintendent Ryan Stewart plays soccer and has been involved in national championship teams at the amateur 30 and over and 40 and over levels.

- Course architect Larry Packard lived at Innisbrook until he passed away at age 101 in 2014.
