Notable

- A long 2025/2026 winter left the course with some winter injury. The cold start of the year took time to get playing conditions back into shape for this year's 3M Open. Agronomy team has been and is continuing to return the golf course to tournament conditions. Many courses in the Twin Cities area are still recovering from the winter; the growing season seems to be 3 weeks behind an average year.
- Before the 2024 tournament, bunkers were rebuilt after a storm with 7" of rain washed out almost every bunker in September of 2023.
- A project removing Green Ash trees continues.
- The land was a sod farm before the golf course was built.
