Additional Notes

- A rough winter killed quite a bit of bermudagrass and some of the zoysiagrass. After the tournament there will be repair to 3 acres of fairway.
- The turf prefers temperatures of more than 90 degrees and has struggle with very mild temperatures this spring.
- Courses in Wichita have suffered from the rough winter and may take a full season to heal.
- Average width of fairways in landing area is 35 yards.
- Troutman is the two-time defending GCSAA Classic overall champion.
